Six months have passed since life radically changed for the world. Like most families on our planet, we decided to stay home. What we did not know then was the great plans our Lord would have for us. He sustained us in times of illness and renewed our strength for what was to come.

Suddenly everything became technological, and the ministry was no exception. We find ourselves working on social media, and with it, reaching places we did not imagine possible.

Using social media, the ministry has started broadcasting every Sunday to continue serving the little ones' needs for spiritual learning. Instead of having 20 or 30 children every Sunday, we find ourselves connected to up to one thousand children at a time.



What sounded like a tragedy to our ministry became a blessing in disguise. Churches in Mexico, Argentina, Cuba, Nicaragua, and Peru of many denominations began to follow us every Sunday.

It has been a great challenge, one we have quickly learned to overcome. Our house became very much like a studio with cables, lights, and little wooden figurines everywhere.

At the beginning of July, we decided to adapt our VBS to a broadcast experience and bring the good news to all those who now needed to hear words of comfort. It was incredible to receive videos of children from many countries singing, praying, and having fun with us. As I said, God had incredible plans for this time, and as we learned in our VBS, we can confidently say, "When Life is scary ... God is good!"

Our entire network of trainers worked very hard from their homes to put together a program that reached thousands of families, something we are all very proud of accomplishing to adapt to these new times.

At the beginning of the year, we had planned to dedicate our indigenous center to serve 100 children, and though still in our hearts, it will now happen at the Lord's time. For now, we will follow the steps that God guides as they are always perfect.
