Dear Friends,

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6

Myanmar is one of the 16 countries that we have child safe homes. Earlier in 2021, there was a military coup in this country. It continues to be a very dangerous situation; there have been killings outside the gate of one of our homes. We were able to move the children quickly to a new home in the country where they will be safe. The move was made during Holy Week. Even though the house parents and children were only there a couple of days, they celebrated Easter and invited many people from the local village to a resurrection feast. Most of the village guests were Buddhists who were able to hear the Gospel even during a war. Would you please pray for the safety of our children and house parents in Myanmar?

We continue to seek the Lord to protect the 1.2 million children sold into the sex trade each year. The statistic is overwhelming. Yet we see hope in the faces of the over 2,200 children who, through Remember Nhu, know freedom in this world and for eternity. One of the strategies of Remember Nhu is to share all that we have learned in the last 12+ years with others who would like to start their own nonprofit organizations focused on ending child sex slavery through prevention.

As part of that strategy, the Lord has led our family to move to Texas. We believe we will be able to make many connections with churches and discipleship schools, which the Lord will use to advance this strategy. Currently, Remember Nhu has no connections in Texas.
